WHITE PINE	Growth Speed: Fast. Mature Height: 50'-80'. Mature Spread: 20'-40'. FAVORED BY RABBITS, & RED SQUIRRELS. NESTING FOR WOODPECKERS, COMMON GRACKLES, MOURNING DOVES, CHICKADEES, & NUTHATCHES.
